If the number of snow/emergency days used is either more or less than five, the calendar will be adjusted accordingly. **If more snow days are needed they will be taken off the April Break beginning with April 15.** *If less than 5 snow days are needed, additional teacher and student "days off" will be provided immediately before and/or after the Memorial Day holiday in May, ensuring the final day of school and high school graduation dates remain in place as published, while still ensuring the district adheres to the 180-day annual student attendance requirement.*
