## SCHOOL CLOSINGS, EARLY DISMISSAL, AND DELAYED OPENINGS

As the winter weather arrives, road conditions can result in school closings, early dismissals, and delayed openings. Full day school closings, delayed openings, and early dismissals are posted on the district website: [www.pthsd.k12.nj.us](http://www.pthsd.k12.nj.us) and on TV (Channels 4,7,12). Families will also receive *School Messenger* alerts. Make sure you keep your contact information current and advise the school of any phone/email/address changes!

### EARLY DISMISSAL

If weather conditions warrant a school closing after the start of the school day an **EARLY DISMISSAL** will be announced.

#### K-5

K-5 students will be dismissed at 1:00 PM.

### SKIP

PM SKIP is **CANCELLED** on **UNSCHEDULED** early dismissal days due to inclement weather or emergency situations. PM SKIP families should notify the school about dismissal arrangements for their children.

It is essential that parents have plans in place to deal with childcare issues on these days. Unless the school is notified differently, the children will follow their usual end of the day procedures.

### DELAYED OPENING

Inclement weather can cause a **2 hour DELAYED OPENING**.

#### K-5

The Delayed Opening school day for K-5 students is 10:55 AM – 3:25 PM.

### SKIP

AM SKIP is **CANCELLED** on delayed opening days.

Buses/vans will pick up students approximately 2 hours later than usual. **DO NOT drop K-5 students off at school BEFORE 10:40 AM.**

**Students will not be supervised nor permitted to enter the building before that time.**

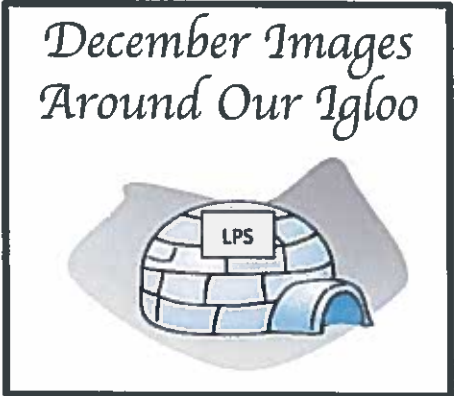
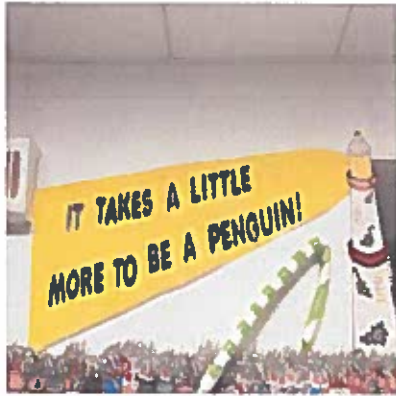
## WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS
